Care Quality Commission (CQC) Registration

Following some confusion about the CQC registration timetable, the GPC has confirmed that NHS GP practices do not yet have to comply with CQC standards.

NHS GP Practices will begin to be invited to apply for registration with CQC from 1 October 2011 and all will need to be registered from 1 April 2012.

In the application practices will need to declare compliance with 16 standards. Monitoring of compliance with the CQC standards will not commence until 1 April 2012.

It is worth noting that PCTMS practices should be registered with CQC because PCTs needed to be registered from 1 April 2010.

The GPC will be producing a guide on how to complete the application form for CQC registration and on how practices can comply with each of the CQC standards. They aim to publish this guide in spring 2011.

The CQC should be sending their first letter to all primary medical services providers about registration this month and will be publishing an introductory guide to registration. In the meantime, information already published can be found on the CQC website at: -

Hackney Carriage/Private Hire Licence Medical Requirements.

Following discussions between Rotherham MBC and the LMC, the RMBC Licensing Manager has asked that the LMC circulate a letter to all GPs outlining three options: -

1) Alter the current system so that GPs continue to complete medicals. However, the certificate of fitness and the medical will be referred to an in-house Occupational Health Unit for an assessment of fitness to be made.

2) Alter the current system so that all medicals are conducted by Occupational Health. 3) Alter the current system to allow drivers to choose either Occupational Health or to a number of GPs who would be prepared to complete the medical forms.

The LMC advises GPs to consider the options carefully as you are potentially being asked to confirm occupational fitness and suitability not just medical information as in an HGV medical.

Hospital Red Alerts

ago, you A year may remember GPs were inundated with alerts. The resulting efforts to reduce the volume have since been successful. NHS Rotherham is now advising the LMC that when an alert is now issued, it really does mean what it says. GPs are asked to show a degree of understanding and compassion in dealing with the Hospital when an alert is now issued!

RDaSH Mental Health NHS Foundation Trust re: mental health services redesign in Rotherham

Dr Riadh Abed, Medical Director, attended the last LMC meeting to outline changes and answer questions from members.

The key change would be that the existing Community Mental Health Teams

(CMHTs) would be remulticonfigured into disciplinary borough -wide specialist teams, which will include an Access Team and four treatment teams. Referrals will be assessed by the Access Team and the most referred to appropriate service. It was envisaged this process would commence February 2011.

The changes will mean approximately 70% of current patients will require transfer to a new care coordinator within the new structure. A communication plan for GPs is set to commence now in advance of the planned February 2011 implementation. A letter will be issued to GPs for each patient informing them of their new Care Coordinator.

Revalidation Update

The LMC can confirm that some GPs are now undergoing the revalidation pilot. As NHS Rotherham has become an early adopter of the new system, the RCGP have offered their appraisal toolkit free to all Rotherham GPs (i.e. irrespective of whether you are a member of RCGP or not) until April 2012. GPs can initiate the service by clicking on the 'revalidation' button on the website at: www.rcgp.org.uk
